

OSHA 10 Hour

This course is ideal for supervisors with safety and health responsibilities and for employee of all levels to raise safety and health awareness. Students will be introduced to OSHA policies, procedures and standards as well as general industry safety and health principles covered in OSHA Act Part 1910. Special emphasis will be placed on areas most hazardous using OSHA standards as a guide. Upon successful completion of the course, participants will receive an OSHA 10-Hour General Industry Outreach DOL course completion card within 4-6 weeks.

Learning Outcomes:

- State the purpose of the OSH Act and list the functions of OSHA
- List the OSHA inspection priorities and describe the inspection process
- Know the rights & responsibilities of employers and employees under the OSH Act
- Outline the general requirements for general safety standards
